5th May Moths: Mary Harold.

Explore the magical world of moths.

6th May (?) Botanical Linocut Printing: Gilly Spottiswoode.

Using pre-cut botanical inspired blocks, Gilly will guide you through the process of printing an image on Japanese paper.

11th May Botanical Illustration: Stef d'Amico.

Using a variety of media and drawing techniques to capture the essence of flower and seed heads. Please bring a sketch book with you.

13th May Herb Gardens and Garlands: Sally and Lyn. Sally, head Gardener at Buckland Abbey for many years, will talk through the selection and propagation of herbs, and Lyn will help you create your own culinary garland.

18th May Garden Mosaics: Kathy Badcock.

Kathy will inspire you with ways in which you can use Mosaics in the Garden and you can create a small project to learn some techniques.

20th May Kusadama: Lyn Edwards.

A Japanese paper folding technique used to create unusual hangings and attractive flowers.

23rd May Garden Sketch Books: Sally O'Neill.

Enjoy drawing in the garden at Delamore. Sally will share her sketch books and guide you in the art of making quick ink and watercolour memories.

25th May Botanical Dyeing and Spinning: Shelagh Brown.

The changing colours of Dartmoor are the inspiration for Shelagh's naturally dyed wool and fleece. Try your hand at spinning and discover a colour palette that can be obtained from the garden.

27th May Draw and Stitch: Stef d'Amico and Lyn Edwards.

Draw your own or use one of our seed head illustrations on fabric, and then stitch to create a cushion panel, book cover or picture.
